DESCRIPTION

Reducing infant mortality is a major public health goal. This webinar will discuss some of the newly published findings from **Breastfeeding** and **Post**perinatal Infant Deaths in the United States, A National Prospective Cohort Analysis, a study of a large dataset of birth-death linked US infants. According to the findings breastfeeding initiation is significantly associated with reduced odds of post-perinatal infant deaths in multiple racial and ethnic groups within the US population. This new study confirms Chen & Rogan's study regarding infant deaths due to NOT breastfeeding; as well as a study from Shelby County, Tennessee. These findings support efforts to improve breastfeeding in infant mortality reduction initiatives.
