We passionately advocate for a society where every family has unencumbered access to human milk in all its forms. Throughout the year, we diligently expanded our programs and member services, delivering impactful initiatives such as our continuing education program and the San Diego County Breastfeeding Resource Guide. The SDCBC distributed approximately 9,500 resource guides to hospitals, clinics, providers, and small businesses/nonprofits—a record-breaking achievement. Additionally, 2023 marked the most successful year for the SDCBC continuing education program.

In our dedicated pursuit of growth, we increased our membership base by an impressive 10% and secured over \$60,000 in grants, sponsorships, and donations to sustain SDCBC operations.




Education




Total Estimated Education Revenue for 2023 \$17,500



San Diego County Breastfeeding Resource Guide


